The time for talking is almost done and, if elected, you would probably prefer fewer words from your political representatives, but rather that they simply deliver on their promises.

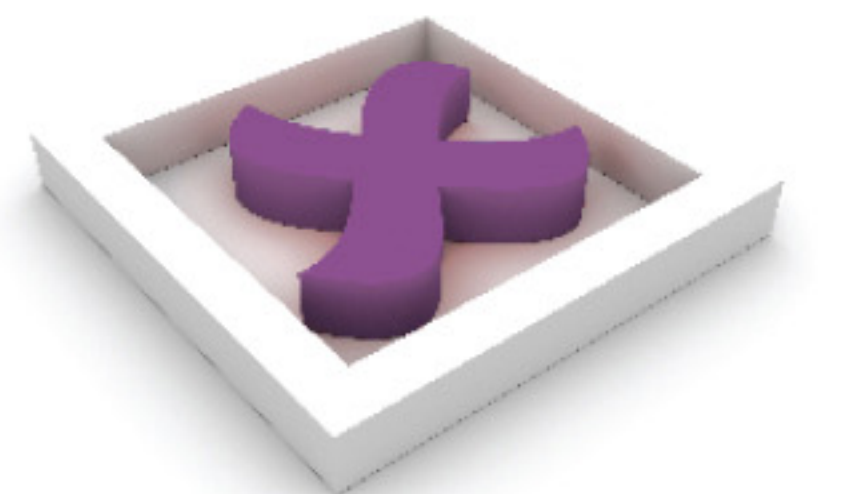
